

Data Privacy Statement

In accordance with current data protection regulations, Eurac Research, as Data Controller (hereinafter the Controller), hereby provides you (the Data Subject) with information about how your data is processed. All personal data is dealt with in compliance with EU Regulation No. 2016/679 (GDPR) and the national legislation.

1. Purpose and legal basis for the Processing

Any and all personal data included in the CV provided by the Data Subject, that is in the possession of the Controller, or that may be requested by the Controller, is necessary for the application process with regard to the eventual future engagement as speaker in the framework of the Winter School on Federalism and Governance. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data for the purposes indicated above is your consent to the processing of your personal data.

2. Methods of processing

Your personal data will be recorded and stored in electronic and paper format. This knowledge and storage of personal data of the Data Subject is necessary in order to process it according to the above-stated purposes. All changes to such data should be immediately communicated to Eurac Research in order to ensure the data's correct processing.

3. Information on the retention period of personal data

Your personal data will be stored for the time period necessary for the selection of the beneficiaries but in any case no longer than 12 months. When this period has been reached, the data shall be deleted or made anonymous.

4. Obligatory or voluntary nature of providing the requested data and possible consequences of failure to provide such data

The provision of your personal data is voluntary, but any refusal to provide such data shall carry with it the impossibility to process the information, thus rendering the application impossible.

5. Recipients of the data processed

The recipients of the data are the staff members of the Institute for Comparative Federalism of Eurac Research or the persons in charge of data processing activities, authorized and instructed by the data controller to data processing activities and the data processor, which were formally bound by means of a data processing agreement (University of Innsbruck as project partner for the recruiting process).

6. Transfer of data

Your personal data will not be transferred to any country or international organization outside European Union.

7. Existence of automated decision-making process

There are no automated decision-making processes.
